No experience is necessary.

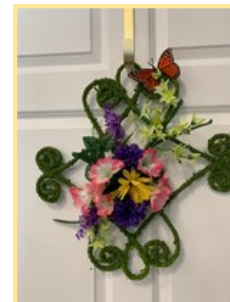


### Flower Trellis Wreath
